Summary of Responsibilities: Under the immediate supervision of the Office Manager of Perkins Family Clinic and the direct supervision of the Director of Health Services, the incumbent will compile and maintain all medical billing records and claims for patients of the PFC health care delivery system for all Medicare, Medicaid and third-party billing claims and the collection of these claims.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned to accomplish work responsibilities.

Reviews completeness of abstract code and clinical data for billing

Posts charges and payments

Maintains and utilizes a variety of health record indexes and storage and retrieval systems

Researches denials, corrects claims, and re-files as needed

Completes daily balance of charges and payments posted

Maintains a confidential health record/billing system

Provides a complete, current, accurate and legible billing records system

Codes medical data to bill on third-party billing claims

Prepares accounts payable on bi-weekly basis and trouble shoots patients bills returned for incorrect address information

Serves as back up to CHS coordinator and/or receptionist

Picks up mail daily

Audits patients charts for accurate information and compliance

Counsels patients on health insurance options and availability

Collects patients payments

Enters data into RIMS or other software system

Compiles data for monthly reports and audits

The applicant must have a degree from an accredited university or technical school in the area of medical billing and one year of work experience in medical billing is required. Actual work experience of 4 years in medical billing will substitute for the educational requirement. The applicant must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily.
